CARBON EMISSIONS REDUCTION PLAN

APIC UK Limited are reviewing our carbon footprint with a view of identifying our current status and formally identifying improvement targets.

For several years we have been making positive steps to improve our environmental profile.

For example whilst we are low producers of waste we have been bailing our cardboard, paper and polythene in order to reduce waste to landfill for almost 15 years.

Our core waste materials are actually very valuable and we have been in a commercial arrangement for our aluminium scrap from the outset of our business.

More recently we have been switching our fleet wherever practical to Hybrid and fully electrical vehicles. We will be shortly installing 6 no. electric charge points at our HQ.

ESG is high on the agenda for APiC's directors and 2023 will see us formalizing our objectives so we can perform even better than we currently do.

We have a very strong supply chain who match, offer and exceed our expectations and this can be evidenced upon request.
